2. In view of the fact that it has not been possible to finalise the up-to-date Seniority List of IRS (C&CE) Officers due to the seniority dispute between DR and promotee Customs Appraisers, which is one of the feeder grades for promotion to IRS (C&CE), all the officers in the grade of Deputy Commissioners who fulfill the eligibility conditions as on the date of eligibility of 01.01.2009 have been considered for promotion and since the seniority position of the officers is yet to be finalised, the promotions are being made without specifying/ determining the inter-se seniority of the officers. For this reason, the names of the officers are placed in the above list in alphabetical order. The Seniority List of Group-A IRS (C&CE) officers can be finalised only after finalisation of the Seniority List of Customs Appraisers.

3. The above promotions to the grade of Joint Commissioner of Customs and Central Excise are purely on ad-hoc basis and shall not confer any right on the officers so promoted for any claim for regular promotion in the grade and the period of such service will not count for seniority or as qualifying service for further promotions. The promotions shall also be subject to outcome of Court cases relating to Seniority dispute of Customs Appraisers.
4. The Controlling Officers concerned shall ensure the officers submitting Charge Assumption Reports pursuant to these promotion orders, are clear from vigilance angle.
5. All the officers mentioned above must be relieved immediately and they must join at their new place of posting **on or before 12.08.2009**, under intimation to the Board. No representations whatsoever shall be entertained before the officers join at their new places of posting.
6. The Chief Commissioners/ Directors General shall send compliance reports regarding relieving and joining of the above officers to the Board (with a copy endorsed to DG, HRD) **by 18.08.2009**.
